### to support your group's needs and learning objectives

Our tailored approach starts with understanding the needs of your faculty by providing custom itineraries with detailed pricing. From the moment you make an inquiry with IVHQ, our dedicated Group Support team will work with you to help your volunteer trip planning, including:

- Understanding your budget constraints
- Finding a destination and volunteering placement best suited to your group's size, preferences, skills, and budget
- Arranging any custom accommodation requirements
- Putting together weekly schedules (volunteering, meals, trips, etc.)
- Organizing local transportation
- Booking additional tours or excursions

We've facilitated over 1,000 trips for student volunteer groups with specialist interests and skills, ranging in size from 8 - 100 members.



# We follow comprehensive approaches to health, safety, risk, and responsible volunteering

## Health, safety, and risk management

- All programs maintain an up-to-date risk assessment to identify potential hazards and implement mitigation strategies.
- Volunteers participate in pre-departure training, an in-person orientation, and on-site training with a focus on health and safety.
- Local teams are trained in first aid. Placements and accommodation have been vetted and are regularly monitored for safety and security.

## Emergency and serious incident response

- ✓ Volunteers have 24/7 access to local staff who can provide access to necessary resources, including evacuation, in the event of a serious emergency or crisis.
- All incidents are reported within 24 hours and IVHQ Program Managers and senior staff can escalate support, as needed.
- Feedback from volunteers and local teams is continually reviewed and used to revise our approach to risk and emergency management.

## Responsible volunteering policies

- We connect volunteers with local leaders who are best suited to identify the most pressing needs and ways to meaningfully get involved in their communities.
- Our responsible volunteer policies are in place to protect children, vulnerable adults, the environment, and welfare of animals.
- We identify the potential ethical issues that can arise when volunteering abroad and implement strict codes of conduct on-site.

## » ACADEMIC CREDIT «

### to support your students' degree plans

#### With your institution

- We regularly work with university faculty and staff to support students who have additional steps to complete before their placement with IVHQ is approved.
- We can provide extensive documentation to satisfy your university travel policies, including health and safety management, risk mitigation, insurance information, and individualized agreements / MOUs.
- Our local teams provide supervision and can complete student evaluations, assessments, or other required student forms.

#### **Through our School of Record**

- We offer a credit-bearing service learning course, which is available across all volunteer destinations and projects.
- Participating students complete self-reflections and written assignments during their volunteer experience and then receive a letter grade based on their submitted coursework.
- At the end of the course, a transcript for 1-5 upper-division internship credits is awarded by the University of Montana, our School of Record partner.


